**Advent:** This week is the third Sunday in Advent and is known as "Gaudete Sunday" Its name is taken from the entrance antiphon of the Mass: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near."

In Latin, the first word of the antiphon is *Gaudete*: which is Latin for "rejoice". On Gaudete Sunday, the season of Advent shifts its focus. For the first two weeks of Advent, the focus can be summed up in the phrase, "The Lord is coming." But beginning with Gaudete Sunday, the summary might be, "The Lord is near." This shift is marked by a heightened sense of joyous anticipation. In times when the focus of our anticipation is often on the negative and fearful, this celebration is a reminder that God who loves us is still in charge and that we await his coming not with fear, but with tremendous joy.
