February 10th - Feast of St. Scholastica, Virgin: St Scholastica was the twin sister of St. Benedict. Born in 480, she founded a religious community for women near Monte Cassino. Her monastery was only about 5 miles from the one of the monasteries founded by St. Benedict. The siblings remained close throughout their lives.
