Sacred Relics of the Saints: Treasures of the Church

St. Cecilia parish in Hastings is sponsoring an educational talk with exposition of Sacred Relics on Sunday, June 19th at 3:00 pm. Father Carlos Martins, a Vatican-appointed expert on relics will be here with an extraordinary Vatican collection of over 150 relics, some as old as 2,000 years. Among the treasures will be relics of St. Cecilia, St. Joseph, St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the “Little Flower”), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska.
