Brothers and Sisters,

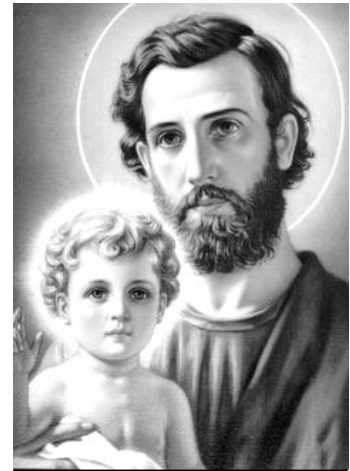
Anuncio vobis gaudium magnum!
