-REMEMBER: November 1, the feast of All Saints Day, is a **HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION**, which means that it holds the same obligation as a Sunday, even though it is on a Thursday this year. Because of this, we will offer three Masses: a 5:30 pm vigil Mass on Wednesday, and 7am and 7 pm on Thursday. If you cannot come to Mass here, go to a nearby parish. We all have the chance to get to Mass. If we “can’t make it”, we need to seriously reconsider our priorities.
