-**ALTAR SOCIETY** will meet in the Parish Hall after Mass today (Sunday, September 8).

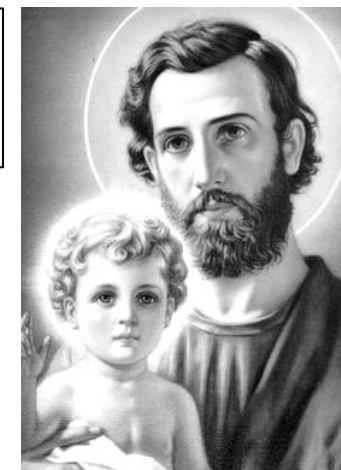

--On October 5, we will begin a new practice in the parish called First Saturday Devotions. This is a common practice, usually joined to First Friday Devotions.
