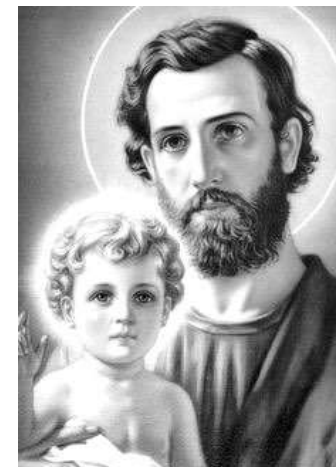
**Feast of the Ascension of the Lord Thursday May 26th:**
